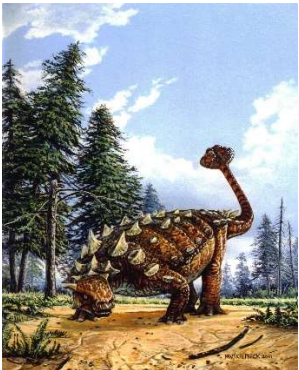


Dinotour 2025

Itinerary:

Friday, July 4, 2025

- Depart from Calgary, Alberta
- Guided tour of the gallery and labs of the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology
- "Dinosite" hike
- Overnight in Drumheller, Alberta

Saturday, July 5, 2025

- Hike to the *Albertosaurus* bonebed in Dry Island Provincial Park
- Overnight in Brooks, Alberta

Sunday, July 6, 2025

- Visit Dinosaur Provincial Park for the day.
- Group previously divided into 4 teams
- Team C: Guided hike to the *Centrosaurus* Bonebed (3 hours), Explorer's bus tour (2 hours) and guided tour of the Dinosaur Provincial Park Field Station
- Team D: guided historic hike (5 hours).
- Overnight in Brooks, Alberta

Monday, July 7, 2025

- Visit Dinosaur Provincial Park for the day.
- Team D: Guided hike to the *Centrosaurus* Bonebed (3 hours), Explorer's bus tour (2 hours) and guided tour of the Dinosaur Provincial Park Field Station
- Team C: guided historic hike (5 hours).
- Return to Calgary, Alberta

Dinotour 2025 involves hiking over steep rugged terrain with elevation gains up to 60 metres (200 feet), lengths up to 5 km (3 miles) and durations up to 5 hours.

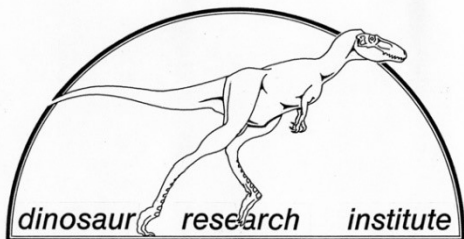

Dinotour 2025, July 4-7, 2025

Dinotour is a unique opportunity to discover Alberta's palaeontological treasures with world-renowned scientists Dr. Philip Currie, Dr. Eva Koppelhus and Dr. Caleb Brown.

During this four-day family-oriented event you will:

- Learn about the dinosaurs of Alberta
- Tour the Royal Tyrrell Museum gallery and the labs and backrooms
- Hike to "Dinosite"
- Hike to the *Albertosaurus* dinosaur quarry in Dry Island Provincial Park
- Explore Dinosaur Provincial Park with hikes and a bus tour

Dr. Philip Currie is Professor, Canada Research Chair at The University of Alberta in the Department of Biological Sciences and the former Curator of Dinosaurs at the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology.

Dr. Eva Koppelhus is Science Instructor II, teaching paleobotany and the evolution of plants, in the department of Biology at the University of Alberta. She is also taking care of the Paleobotany and Palynology Collections.

Dr. Caleb Brown is the Curator of Dinosaur Systematics & Evolution at the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology.

Mona Trick is the coordinator for this tour and amateur palaeontologist. She co-wrote the book "Common Vertebrate Fossils from the Cretaceous of Alberta".

Dinotour 2025 includes:

- Guided tour including bus transportation to and from Calgary
- 3 nights accommodation (double occupancy) and all meals
- Admission to the activities at the Royal Tyrrell Museum and Dinosaur Provincial Park
- Guidebook and T-shirt
- Canadian charitable tax donation receipt for a significant portion of the fees
